Side 1 • Small Group # 1
15 minutes



WELCOME

Welcome each kid by name.

Ask:

- *Raise your hand if you would like to lift a really heavy rock.*
- *Raise your hand if you would like to jump really high.*



BIBLE

Give each kid a Bible.

Say:

- *We are going to hear a story about a man who needed help from Jesus.*
- *Whenever you hear the word 'man,' hold up your hand to your ear to listen close to what Jesus tells him.*

Read:

- *Jesus Heals A Blind Beggar: Page 371*

Review:

- *Do you like to see things with your eyes?*
- *What do you like to look at?*



PRAY

Pray: *Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to help us with anything. This week, please help (list each child's name) ask you for help with whatever they might need. We know your power is with Jesus and Jesus can do anything. We love you. Amen.*



ACTIVITY

Say: *We are going to play with our Parachute today. As we play, I am going to tell you to close your eyes and pretend you are blind like the man in our story today.*

- *Play with the Parachute, occasionally instructing everyone to close their eyes, and then open them.*

Continue the activity until Large Group.

SNACK TIME

Provide snack to kids while they are seated around a table.

- Review the Bottom Line
- Say the Memory Verse for your Group

Remain seated around the table until Parent Pick Up.



TAKE HOME

As kids leave, prompt them to share today's story with their family on the car ride home.



PRO TIP

This month LCBC is focusing on ways we can serve. Even kids in Oyster Bay can serve! Have them give high fives to friends who are playing a game, encourage them to cheer for those dancing during worship, and acknowledge how they clean up their toys. This helps them to learn ways they can serve inside and outside of church.

15 minutes



Welcome each kid by name.

Ask:

- Raise your hand if you like to climb trees.
- Raise your hand if you like to throw a ball really far.



Give each kid a Bible.

Say:

- We are going to hear a story about a man who needed help from Jesus.
- Whenever you hear the word 'man,' hold up your hand to your ear to listen close to what Jesus tells him.

Read:

- Jesus Heals A Blind Beggar: Page 371

Review:

- What happened to the man in this story?
- Who made the man see?



Pray: Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to help us with anything. This week, please help (list each child's name) ask you for help with whatever they might need. We know your power is with Jesus and Jesus can do anything. We love you. Amen.



Say:

- Our story today was about a time Jesus found a friend who was sitting down.
- We are going to play a fun game of sit and stand. Let's sit crisscross applesauce.
- Now everyone stand up and say, 'Jesus can do anything!'
- Now let's pretend to be frogs sitting on a lily pad.
- Now stand up and say Jesus can do anything!
- Let's sit down as fast as you can when I say 'go'. 3, 2, 1, GO!
- Now stand up and say, 'Jesus can do anything!'
- Now let's try standing like a flamingo and say, 'Jesus can do anything!'
- Let's sit like chickens on eggs.
- Let's stand like kings and queens and say, 'Jesus can do anything!'

Keep playing thinking of different ways kids can sit or stand while saying this month's Bottom Line.

Continue the activity until Large Group.

SNACK TIME

Provide snack to kids while they are seated around a table.

- Review the Bottom Line
- Say the Memory Verse for your Group

Remain seated around the table until Parent Pick Up.



TAKE HOME

Parents will be taking home this month's Memory Verse today.

- Share that their child learns a Memory Verse each month.
- Encourage them to put it somewhere they spend time together so they can practice during the week.



PRO TIP

You can help 2-year-olds grow in their emotions and connect them to God through the Bible story. Point out how different people in the story are feeling. Ask kids to mimic that feeling with their face. At the end of the story, point out that Jesus helped people to feel happy!

WELCOME

Welcome each kid by name.

Ask:

- *Raise your hand if you like to jump rope really fast.*
- *Raise your hand if you like to swing really high.*



BIBLE

Give each kid a Bible.

Say:

- *We are going to hear a story about a man who needed help from Jesus.*
- *Whenever you hear the word 'man,' hold up your hand to your ear to listen close to what Jesus tells him.*

Read:

- *Jesus Heals A Blind Beggar: Page 371*

Review:

- *What are your favorite things to see?*
- *Do you think Jesus can help us when we need help?*



PRAY

Pray: *Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to help us with anything. This week, please help (list each child's name) ask you for help with whatever they might need. We know your power is with Jesus and Jesus can do anything. We love you. Amen.*



ACTIVITY

Take out the String and place it in a straight line on the floor.

- *Instruct kids to stand in a line at the top of the string and take turns walking and balancing on the line.*
- *As kids take turns walking, have your Group practice the Memory Verse.*
- *To add variety, you can add some turns or waves in the string pattern.*

Continue the activity until Large Group.

SNACK TIME

Provide snack to kids while they are seated around a table.

- Say the Memory Verse for your Group

TAKE HOME

As kids leave, prompt them to share today's story with their family on the car ride home.



PRO TIP

Transitioning to the table for Small Group can be hard. Instead of telling kids to go sit, ask, "Who can hop like a frog to the table?" or "Can you flap your wings like a bird as we sit down?" Once they are sitting, celebrate them coming together in a group.

WELCOME

Ask:

- Raise your hand if you like to build really tall sandcastles.
- Raise your hand if you like to build big stick forts.



BIBLE

Give each kid a Bible.

Say:

- We are going to hear a story about a man who needed help from Jesus.
- Whenever you hear the word 'man,' hold up your hand to your ear to listen close to what Jesus tells him.

Read:

- Jesus Heals A Blind Beggar: Page 371

Review:

- Jesus helped the man in our story!
- When was the last time someone helped you?



PRAY

Pray: Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to help us with anything. This week, please help (list each child's name) ask you for help with whatever they might need. We know your power is with Jesus and Jesus can do anything. We love you. Amen.



ACTIVITY

Give everyone a Blind Man Coloring Page.

- Allow them to color and review the Bible Story as they color.

Continue the activity until Large Group.

SNACK TIME

As kids leave, prompt them to share today's story with their family on the car ride home.

- Blind Man Coloring Page



PRO TIP

It can be hard for 2-year-olds to sit in Small Group! Keep them engaged by making it fun and interactive. When asking kids if they like to build sandcastles, have them show you how big. When they are coloring their activity sheet, ask them to use the color of the sun or the color of grass. This keeps kids engaged with the activity and connected with you!

BIBLE

Give each kid a Bible.

Say:

- *We are going to hear a story about a man who needed help from Jesus.*
- *Whenever you hear the word 'man,' hold up your hand to your ear to listen close to what Jesus tells him.*

Read:

- *Jesus Heals A Blind Beggar: Page 371*

Review:

- *The man believed Jesus was going to heal him, that's why he ran to the water to wash off his eyes!*
- *What do you believe Jesus can do?*



PRAY

Pray: *Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus to help us with anything. This week, please help (list each child's name) ask you for help with whatever they might need. We know your power is with Jesus and Jesus can do anything. We love you. Amen.*



ACTIVITY

Take out the Easter Invites.

- *Easter is a very exciting holiday! Raise your hand if you love Easter!*
- *Can anyone tell me what they love about Easter?*
- *We want all of our friends to come to LCBC to celebrate Easter together this year!*

Help kids think of some people in their life who they can invite to Easter at LCBC.

- *Help them fill out their names on the invites.*

Continue the activity until Large Group.
