WELCOME

Welcome each kid by name and Ask:

- If you would like to live in a tree house touch your nose.
- If you would like to live in an igloo shiver like you are cold.

BIBLE

Say:

- We are going to hear a story about the most special baby that was ever born.
- Every time we hear Jesus' name, let's all rock our hands like we are holding a baby!

TIPS + TRICKS



Toddlers love to pretend! As you read the story about Jesus' birth, encourage kids to take care of an imaginary baby Jesus. After they rock the baby, ask them to give it a bottle, sing a lullaby, or burp it! Remind them that as Baby Jesus grew up, he did amazing things!

PRAY

ACTIVITY

- Cheer them on for inviting.

- You are all getting Christmas Invites to take home today so you can invite people to come to church with you this Christmas! Does anyone have a name of someone they want to come to church with them?
- Hand out invites and write the names of the people they would like to invite on their invites.

WELCOME

Welcome each kid by name and Say:

- Clap your hands if you like to build snowmen.
- Stomp your feet if you like to make a snow angel.

- Every time we hear Jesus' name, let's all rock our hands like we are holding a baby!

- Prompt the kids to respond: Jesus is God's son!
- Keep playing!
